Step back in time to the Old Aldeburgh of seafaring stories, smuggling haunts and shipwrecks.

This multisensory session has been inspired by the book 'Up the Steps' by Dr Nora Acheson.

Key Stage: KS2

Curriculum links: History: A local history study. A theme in British history.

English: Listen and respond appropriately. Participate in performances and role play. Ask questions and discuss.

Capacity: 30 pupils per session

Session price: £3 per pupil. Adults free.

Pupils will:

- Read or listen to the book 'Up the Steps' in preparation for their visit.
- Discover the history of Aldeburgh through selected museum displays, linked to the book.
- Meet a 'real' costumed smuggler and learn more about the smuggling trade in and around Aldeburgh.
- Investigate real objects from our 'treasure trove' handling collection.
- Visit the Aldeburgh Lifeboat Station and meet one of the lifeboat crew.
- Have a look at a restored fishing beach boat on the seafront.
