This multisensory session has been inspired by Edward Ardizzone's book "Little Tim and the brave sea captain"

Key Stage: Reception/KS1

Curriculum links: **History:** Significant historical events, people and places in their own locality
English: Listen and respond. Ask relevant questions. Participate in discussions.

Capacity: 30 pupils per session

Session price: £3 per pupil. Adults free

Pupils will:

- Listen to the story of "Little Tim and the brave sea captain" and enjoy the accompanying storysack in preparation for their visit.
- Learn more about Aldeburgh seafaring history through the museum displays.
- Dress up as the crew on a Victorian Steamer ship.
- Meet a 'real' costumed Sea Captain and listen to his stories of the sea.
- Visit the Aldeburgh Lifeboat Station and meet one of the crew.
